Paddling Notes

- Fairly sheltered waters, pleasant camps, but see caution below
- Early spring and late fall the sun will leave your camp in shadow
- Caution, southerly winds (inflow) can be very strong in the afternoon and can greatly reduce your paddling time or even stop you returning to Tawanek.

Getting There

Driving Directions [Google Maps: Vancouver Museum – Tawanek, Sechelt Inlet](#)
BC Ferries from [Horseshoe Bay to Langdale](#) on the Sunshine Coast. Drive 30 minutes to Sechelt. Turn right at the traffic lights down the hill in Sechelt. Turn right again at the four-way stop 1 km later. Follow Porpoise Bay Rd. onto Sechelt Inlet Rd. for 3km. Continue 5km past Porpoise Bay Prov. campground.

Travel Distance - Total	79 kms	2 h 29 min
- Ferry	Horseshoe Bay to Langdale	1 h 10 min
Paddle to nearest campsite	3.5 NM to Nine-Mile Point See Map	(next page)

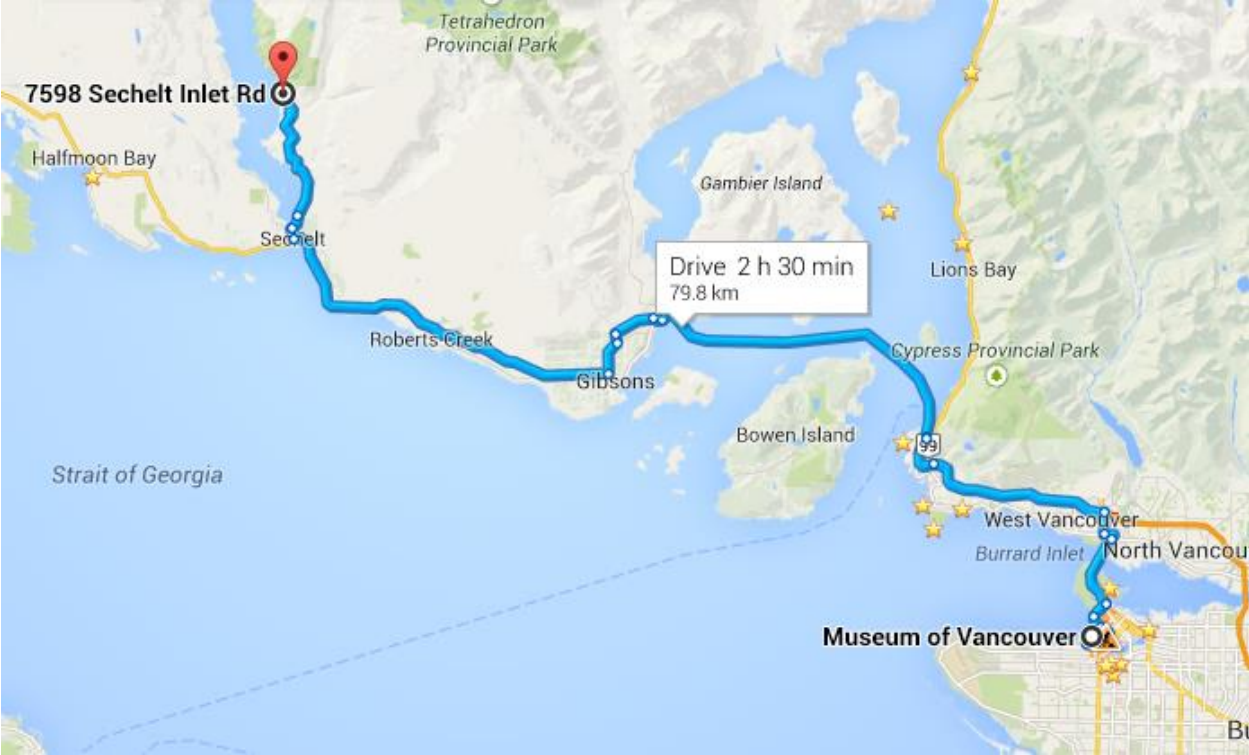
