1. Management of Operations

a) Maintenance & Projects

The six Sea to Sky Marine Trail sites in Howe Sound are Recreation Sites established by the British Columbia Marine Trails Network Association (BCMTNA), Trans Canada Trail and RSTBC in 2015. In the spring of 2017 the Sea Kayak Association of British Columbia (SKABC), a Vancouver based sea kayak club, entered into a partnership agreement with RSTBC to look after maintenance of the six sites.

In 2018 the following maintenance and projects were performed:

1) **Tantalus Landing Table** – On April 14 & 15, 2018, a volunteer team built a large custom table on an existing concrete base at Tantalus Landing. A coat of linseed oil was subsequently applied. Rounds from a bucked-up hazard tree have been used for seating.

- 2) **Spring Site Inspections** Site inspections were carried out by powerboat at all six sites May 12 & 13, 2018. Minor work was done on the sites.
- 3) Visitor Logbooks Waterproof logbooks were installed in plastic cases at all sites during the May 12 & 13 site visits. There is also an online logbook that can be accessed through the SKABC website, although it does not appear to be getting much use compared to the logbooks at the sites. One plastic case was broken over the course of the season and required replacement, and two pens had to be replaced. One logbook (at a site used by camp children) was subject to graffiti.

- 4) Danger Trees Two SKABC volunteers went to all sites May 9 with a danger tree assessor and Jeff Levine of Sea to Sky Adventure Company. Powerboat transportation provided by Sea to Sky Adventure Company. Only a few danger trees at most sites, but a large number at Zorro Bay. Falling was then carried out by BC Wildfire Service. Two fallers and a cleanup crew member at the sites for three days.
- 5) **Picnic Tables -** Five picnic tables were built by SKABC volunteers using recycled cedar decking, and painted the official dark brown RSTBC colour. Three SKABC volunteers delivered them to the sites August 6.

- 6) **Fall Site Inspections** On the weekend of October 13/14, 2018, site inspections were carried out by powerboat at all six sites. Minor work was done on the sites.
- 7) **Tantalus Landing Bridge** On October 17 & 18, four SKABC Volunteers completed most of the work for a two-log bridge over the creek at Tantalus Landing. Decking of the bridge remains to be done, as well as steps up the bridge at the south end.

- 8) **Zorro Bay Toilet** Installation of a urine-diverting composting toilet has been delayed and is now scheduled for early in 2019.
- 9) Video/Presentations A video on the Howe Sound sites was presented at the BC Marine Trails Spring Forum April 7, 2018, followed by an expanded presentation at the May 7, 2018 SKABC meeting. The video is now online at the SKABC website and can be accessed via the following link:

b) Volunteers

26 volunteers from SKABC visited the sites for the maintenance and projects noted above.

c) Incidents and Actions

- 1) All six site are boat access only and are not patrolled on a regular basis.
- 2) In early 2018, it was noted that the Squamish language panel of the Ramillies Channel site sign had been broken off (vandalism presumed)

- and was on the ground beside the sign. A SKABC volunteer retrieved the panel by kayak and delivered it to the RSTBC office. RSTBC had the panel repaired and it was reinstalled by SKABC volunteers during the May site inspections.
- 3) One logbook plastic case and pen were broken at Islet View which may have been vandalism, although the logbook was intact. The logbook case was replaced during the Aug. 6, 2018 picnic table delivery and there has been no damage noted since.
- 4) The site visitor logbook at Thornbrough Channel was subject to graffiti. It is noted that this site is used by Camp Potlatch and it is likely that the graffiti was done by a youngster. Several pages were marked up but the logbook remains usable.
- 5) No other incidents or actions were reported.

d) Management Concerns

Following are the most significant current management concerns:

- 1) None of the six sites currently have latrine facilities (a urine-diverting composting toilet is in progress for Zorro Bay). Users are expected to use Leave No Trace practices:
 - i. Go below tide line, cover with rocks or sand, or
 - ii. Dig a small hole well away from streams, cover with soil.
 - iii. Pack out toilet paper.

Unburied human waste and toilet paper were found at two sites. Additional signage has been posted in the food cache boxes. In the longer term, outhouses should be provided at all sites, starting with the most heavily used sites.

2) Two sites, Thornbrough Channel and Tantalus Landing, require bridges at creek crossings. Most of the work for a two-log bridge over the creek at Tantalus Landing has been completed in 2018. Decking of the bridge remains to be done, as well as steps up to the bridge at the south end. No work has been done yet on the bridge at Thornbrough Channel.

e) Enforcement Support

No enforcement support is currently required.

2. Summary of Visitors and Revenue

a) Visitors

Visitor logbooks were installed at all six sites on May 12 & 13, 2018. The following visits were recorded based on onsite and online logbook entries:

a. Ramillies Channel – 11 day visitors. 114 overnight visitors, including 3 groups from Camp Fircom.

- **b. Bain Creek** 8 day visitors. 139 overnight visitors, including 7 groups from Camp Potlatch.
- **c. Thornbrough** 43 day visitors, including 1 group from Camp Potlatch. 67 overnight visitors, including 3 groups from Camp Potlatch.
- **d. Islet View** 41 day visitors, including 1 group from Camp Potlatch. 86 overnight visitors, including 3 groups from Camp Potlatch.
- e. Zorro Bay 75 day visitors. 38 overnight visitors.
- **f.** Tantalus Landing 41 day visitors. 18 overnight visitors.

Total for all sites: 219 day visitors, 462 overnight visitors. It is known from anecdotal evidence that some day and overnight visits were not entered in the logbooks, so actual site usage is higher.

Four sites, Ramillies Channel, Bain Creek, Thornbrough Channel, Islet View and saw visits by large parties from Camp Fircom and Camp Potlatch.

Zorro Bay saw significant day use by powerboat, and it is likely that there were more visits that were not recorded. At other sites, the majority of visits were by self-propelled watercraft (kayak, canoe and stand-up paddleboard).

b) Revenue

All six site are boat access only and no fees are charged for use.

\$5000 per year is provided to SKABC from RSTBC for maintenance and projects on the six sites. The 2018 revenue has been allocated to the Zorro Bay composting urine diverting toilet.

3. Summary of Expenses

In 2018, expenses were incurred for the following maintenance and projects:

- 1) Zorro Bay Toilet Composting urine diverting toilet. In progress.
- b) Spring site condition reports
 - 1) Powerboat and camping
- c) Picnic tables
 - 1) Powerboat and materials (wood was salvaged at no cost).
- d) Fall site condition reports
 - 1) Powerboat and camping
- e) Bridge construction at Tantalus Landing
 - 1) Powerboat and materials (logs and decking were salvaged at no cost).

SKABC will invoice separately for the above expenses.

4. Year End Condition of Infrastructure

- a) Generally, all sites are in good shape and show evidence of moderate use.
- b) Bathroom etiquette signs are present at all sites.
- c) Food cache boxes, new in 2017, are in good shape. Some minor garbage was found in some boxes.
- d) Unburied human waste and toilet paper were found at two sites, with some evidence of creek areas being used as toilets.
- e) One danger tree was left in place at Ramillies Channel due to wildlife values.
- f) Garbage, from a garbage pit exposed at Ramillies Channel when a hazard tree was felled, has been bagged and requires removal by powerboat.

5. Proposed Projects and Planning for the Coming Year

- a) It is anticipated that the urine-diverting composting toilet at Zorro Bay will be completed in early 2019. Based on the Zorro Bay experience, discussions will be held with RSTBC regarding toilets for the remaining Howe Sound sites.
- b) On the following pages is a table outlining possible 2019 projects for the Howe Sound sites. Projects will be prioritized over the winter and will proceed as volunteers and resources become available.

Site Visitor Logbook - Bain Creek





Site Visitor Logbook - Thornbrough Channel


